Studio North is a six day intensive building workshop. The workshop offers students the opportunity to engage with the rural landscape and to imagine, develop and construct inventive design solutions. The workshop takes place in Norwich, Vermont. Each session investigates a particular interest and responds with the design and construction of a complete prototype structure.
